DAY 1: JAIPUR – AGRA (Approx..4 Hrs/15 Min & 240 Kms) After breakfast check out from your hotel and drive to Agra enroute visiting Fatehpur Sikri. Fatehpur Sikri is a deserted city built by Emperor Akbar to commemorate the birth of his son. On arrival at Agra Check in at Hotel

DAY 2: AGRA-DELHI : Wake up early and start your sightseeing of Agra city early with a mesmerizing view of the sunrise along with the Taj Mahal. Take a guided tour inside the Taj Mahal for approximately two hours. Taj Mahal is a UNESCO World Heritage site which has been declared as the New 7 wonders of the world. It was built by Shah Jahan in the memory his beloved begum Mumtaz. Yamuna river gives a breathtaking background and the green gardens adds on to the beauty of the monument. Then return to the hotel for breakfast. After that, check out from hotel, and visit the historic Agra Fort. Agra Fort Your guide teaches you its fascinating history. See the Fort's different apartments and enjoy its magnificent architecture. Agra Fort is a UNESCO World Heritage site which is a historical fort in the city of Agra. It was originally the main residence of the Mughal Emperors. This fort contains various other sites which makes one aware of the magnificent history of India. Tomb of Itimad-ud-Daulah It's also called Baby Taj, It's a Mughal mausoleum in the city of Agra in the Indian state of Uttar Pradesh. Along with the main building, the structure consists of numerous outbuildings and gardens. The tomb, built between 1622 and 1628, represents a transition between the first phase of monumental Mughal architecture – primarily built from red sandstone with marble decorations, as in Humayun's Tomb in Delhi.
